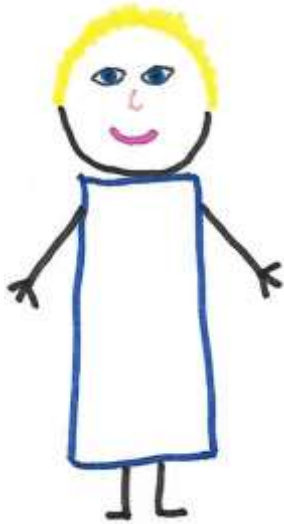


The Numerical Adventures of Bobby and Bunny

Bobby and Bunny are going to play with marbles today. Before they can play, they have to find the marbles. Bunny looks in the toy box:



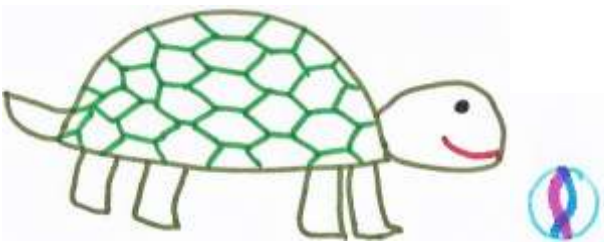
One, two, three, four... Oh! That isn't enough marbles for a game. Bobby looks under the sofa in the living room:
